BRINGING THE CITY TO THE STREET

One-Painting-Window-Show at Gus' Pub

Kyle Jackson is unveiling his latest in a series of Halifax city paintings outside of Gus' Pub on the corner of North and Agricola. For one hour, on Thursday, June 25, Kyle will be hosting a reception on the sidewalk and speaking about the painting displayed in the South window. "Since becoming the cook at Gus' Pub earlier this year, I have become more aware of the neighbourhood vibe and I think this is reflected in my new work. Dimo and Maria Georgakakos were kind enough to lend me their window in order to display this painting out onto the street."

The iconic Gus' Pub, a 48-year-old neighbourhood fixture, is a fitting place to display Kyle's newest cityscape. The artist is attempting to offer an alternative to the *white cube gallery experience* by bringing his art, literally, to the pedestrian level. Located in the heart of the North End, this unique showcase offers passers by a birds' eye view of their city, in a Google Map-meets-Nova Scotia Folk Art experience. This work is an example of Jackson's style of *urban outsider art*, which attempts to amplify characteristics of the artists' surroundings and relate to the exhibition location.
